### Lacunza San Sebastián

Net cost after scholarship: \$ 2,335

Lacunza – International House (IH) San Sebastián is the most prestigious language school in San Sebastián and is attended by more than 1,000 students a year. It is popular with film buffs, being home to the prestigious San Sebastian International Film Festival, while it is also considered a surfer's paradise!

## Madrid
